



**RESOLUTION NO. 10 OF 2010
COUNTY OF CLARION
FFY 2010 CDBG PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Supervisors have submitted a FFY 2010 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Competitive Application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) involving the replacement of existing sanitary sewer lines in the Fryburg Sewage System. The application requests a CDBG Competitive grant of \$416,735, with the total project cost being \$446,335, and allocates \$5,000 for grant administration. ; and

WHEREAS, should DCED decide to approve this Competitive CDBG Grant Application, regardless of the total allocation, the Washington Township Supervisors have requested that the Clarion County Department of Planning and Development administer the grant; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the County of Clarion, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, on behalf of the Clarion County Department of Planning and Development, hereby declares its intent to administer and manage the FFY 2010 Competitive Grant, if approved. The proposed use and application of the administration allocation of \$5,000 will be to administer the sanitary sewer line replacement project being undertaken by Washington Township.; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County does hereby designate David G. Cyphert, Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, along with Donna R. Hartle and Timothy P. Reddinger, County Commissioners, as the officials authorized to execute all documents necessary to the administration of the FFY 2010 CDBG Competitive Grant, if approved.; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County approves the content of the application submitted to DCED, contingent upon the incorporation of comments received subsequent to the public hearings and any requirements stipulated by DCED.


